

# CALL No. 20 (2020): SUPPORT FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF ACADEMIC EVENTS IN MARINE SCIENCES

At CEMarin we are pleased to share this call to offer support for the organization of academic event in marine sciences. This call is intended to support CEMarin researchers' key academic events that seek to promote marine sciences in Colombia, such as conferences, congresses, workshops, etc. It aims to assist national and international academic activities developed in Colombia or Germany, in order to share ideas, results, knowledge, and enhance networking among and between academia, the general public, policymakers, entrepreneurs, and all other stakeholders related to marine sciences.

**Published:** 4<sup>th</sup> September 2020

**Deadline for applications:** All year round. The call will run as long as funds remain available.

## Objective of the call

- Support researchers or research groups from our member universities to organize events aimed at promoting marine sciences in Colombia.

**Aimed at:** CEMarin researchers from our member universities.

## Categories of support

- Organizational support: CEMarin researchers can receive support in the organization of their events, either virtual or face to face, such as: promotional stands, the development of event-related materials, Google Guaranteed Ads, graphic design, among others.
- Financial support: CEMarin can provide economic support up to a maximum of \$6,000,000 Colombian Pesos (COP) per event, to be executed exclusively for the development of the event. The funds will be administered by CEMarin and paid directly to the researcher or to the suppliers of the requested goods and services.

## Specific criteria for events

The following criteria will be used to prioritize events to receive funding:

- The application must be submitted at least two (2) months before the event.
- The event must be related to at least one of our CEMarin [research lines](#).
- CEMarin must be included as a co-organizer of the event in all graphic and promotional material.

- International participants should be invited.
- The event must connect the scientific community with other stakeholders (e.g. local communities, companies, policymakers, etc.).
- The event should support students to develop their careers in marine sciences.
- The event should increase scientific and technical innovation in the field of marine sciences.

### **Application steps and requirements**

The applicant must complete the following online form:

- The application must include all relevant information in the form: budget, aims, scope and a tentative agenda for the event.
- The application must be written in English.
- Applications that do not adhere to these requirements may be rejected.

In the case that CEMarin requires more information about the event, the applicant must send all relevant documentation to [convocatorias@cemarin.org](mailto:convocatorias@cemarin.org)

### **Commitments upon receiving support**

Researchers must provide evidence of the use of the resources (e.g. invoices, contracts, etc.). The researcher must guarantee that CEMarin will be acknowledged and visible during the event.
