

## BECOME A CEMARIN ASSOCIATED RESEARCHER

At CEMarin, we believe in the importance of building connections between institutions and organizations for the growth of the scientific community and its contribution to social development. Therefore, we are committed to strengthening and enriching our network of researchers by including active researchers associated with institutions that are not part of the Corporation. We present the opportunity to become an official CEMarin member through the Associated Researcher category. As an Associated Researcher, you will have access to our calls for proposals to secure funding for research project development and receive specialized guidance in seeking additional resources for your initiatives. This expanded collaboration is essential for enhancing marine science research and maximizing the impact of your projects.

Associated Researchers at CEMarin are active researchers from institutions not part of the Corporation who have expressed their intention to contribute actively to it.

### Requirements:

- Hold a doctoral degree and/or be a university professor.
- Evidence of participation as a Principal Investigator in at least one project or as a co-investigator in at least three projects.
- Invitation letter from a CEMarin Researcher.
- Motivation letter.

### Benefits:

- Assistance with the fundraising process for your project proposals.
- Attendance at CEMarin events (fees may be waived or applied depending on the event).
- Participation in internal calls of the Corporation if your proposals involve at least one CEMarin researcher.

### Commitments:

- Support the visibility of CEMarin.
- Evaluate research proposals assigned to you and received within the framework of CEMarin's calls for proposals.

### How to Become a CEMarin Associated Researcher:

If you are interested in joining this team, send a motivation letter to [convocatorias@cemarin.org](mailto:convocatorias@cemarin.org) with a copy to [people@cemarin.org](mailto:people@cemarin.org), requesting the Scientific Committee of the Corporation to grant you the Associated Researcher category. In your letter, explain why you wish to join. Attach

your updated CV in English and a letter from a CEMarin researcher endorsing your application. Additionally, complete the [Application form to become a CEMarin Associated researcher](#).

The Committee will review your request and respond via email. Once you are affiliated with the Corporation as an Associated Researcher, you will be able to participate in calls directed to CEMarin researchers.
