At CEMarin, we are committed to the growth of the scientific community and its contribution to social development. To achieve this, we are establishing a multidisciplinary network of researchers to strengthen marine science research. If you are part of a member institution of our Corporation, we offer you the opportunity to become an official CEMarin member. This will allow you to connect, share ideas, and collaborate on joint projects with member universities. As part of our network, you will have access to our funding calls for research project development and gain entry to a collaborative environment with essential resources to advance your marine science research.

CEMarin researchers are professors and leaders of research groups from institutions within the Corporation who have expressed their intention to actively contribute. Currently, our team consists of over ninety scientists from Colombia and Germany.

Requirements:

1. Be a professor and lead or be part of a research group at one of the CEMarin member institutions: Universidad Nacional de Colombia, Universidad de los Andes, Universidad del Valle, Universidad de Bogotá Jorge Tadeo Lozano, Universidad de Antioquia, Justus Liebig Universität Giessen, Leibniz Centre for Tropical Marine Research (ZMT), Universidad del Magdalena, or Universidad de Cartagena.
2. Your research must align with one or more of the Corporation's research lines.

Benefits:

1. Connect with our network of researchers to share ideas, projects, and work on joint initiatives with member universities.
2. Participate in CEMarin's calls for proposals to secure funding for research project development.
3. Receive guidance in seeking additional funding to execute your research projects.

Commitments:

3. Evaluate research proposals assigned to you and received within the framework of CEMarin's calls for proposals.
